	4'	6'	Sun/ part shade	D	Summer	M	Light green foliage; does best with morning sun and afternoon shade; attracts hummingbirds
	10"	3'	Sun/part shade	D	Spring to Summer	M	Dwarf variety include 'Katie' or 'Bonita'; reseeds profusely
	6-12"	2'	Sun	E	Spring to Frost	L	Spreading habit; low growing groundcover with finely cut leaves; butterflies enjoy
	4-6'	6'	Part shade/ shade	D		M	Attractive berries fall and winter; needs deeper soil; prefers dependable moisture
	4-6'	4-6'	Sun/part shade	D		M	Colorful burgundy foliage; dense form with thorns; best color in full sun; needs good drainage
	1-3'	3'	Sun	D	Fall	L	Requires little water, long roots will find water some distance away; excellent nectar source
	3-5'	4-5'	Sun	D	Summer to Fall	L	Prickly; give lots of room; attracts butterflies
	4'	3'	Sun	E	Spring to Frost	M	Repeat bloomer; new variety good disease resistance; upright growth habit
	2-3'	4'	Sun	E	Early Summer	L	Long blade-like leaves with sharp edges (not pedestrian friendly); needs space
	2-4'	6-8'	Part shade/ shade	D	Summer and Fall	L-H	Graceful, drooping wheat-like seed heads, spreads freely; prefers moist areas
	2'	2'	Sun	D		M	Elegant weeping form; very drought tolerant; reseeds; more appropriate in meadow, prairie or wetland
